#### HOW DO WE ENSURE ACCOUNTABILITY?

 Parents/guardians must confirm that their child did indeed read the books that they say they did by signing a take-home form to be returned to their teacher in September along with either the bingo sheet or the recommended reading list and the 'Books Finished' page tracker.

#### HOW WILL STUDENTS CLAIM THEIR PRIZES?

 On our first week back at school, students who have prizes to claim can be sent to the library during their language arts period to claim their prizes. I will have a large table set up with all of their choices.


